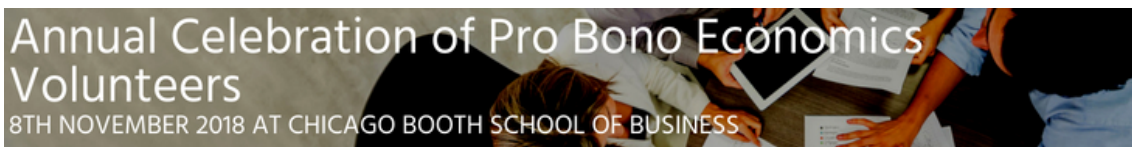




Upcoming Events

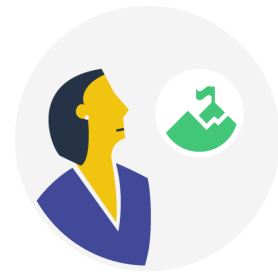
